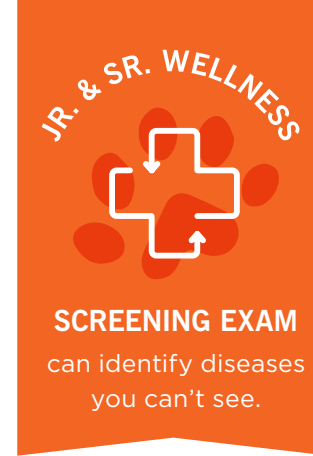
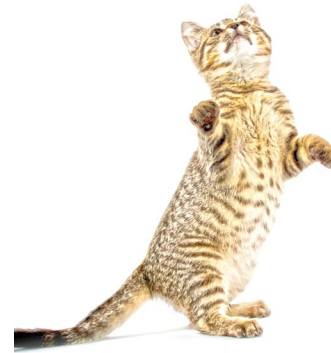

Junior & Senior Wellness Testing

|  Junior Cats (Less than 7 years old) | Chemistry Panel with Complete Blood Count (CBC), Urinalysis & Fecal and Feline Serology (felv/fiv) |
|  Senior Cats | Chemistry Panel with Complete Blood Count (CBC), Basic Thyroid Monitoring, Urinalysis & Fecal, Feline Serology |
